

## **David Allen in the Moravian Records (1768-1769)**

Early 1768. Building in Salem was continued. The cellar wall for the fifth house on the main street caved in and had to be replaced. Boards were bought from David Allen, and were hauled from the Landing Place on the Yadkin to Salem. (p373)

3/4/1768. The Brn. Reuter and Trebel went by the way of Bethania to the Landing Place at Isaac Free's plantation on the Yadkin, where yesterday David Allen brought a good lot of pine boards for us. (p377)

4/4/1769. Wagons went to the Yadkin for boards for Salem. They had been cut at Mr. Allen's saw-mill, and floated down to Isaac Ferry's landing, but could not be hauled out across a field until the corn on it was ripe. (p389)
