<u>Ezra Deborde</u> was born about 1825, and he married Mary C. Boaz in 1849 in Wilkes Co, NC. They raised their family in the vicinity of Traphill, Absher, and Joines. Their daughter Sarah Ann DeBorde (b1853) married William Harrison Brooks and they lived near the Wilkes/Alleghany county line. Ezra died in 1863 during a Civil War battle in Tennessee. As these documents state, he left home in October and died the next month in November from his injuries.
